The Stewards received a report from the Clerk of the Course stating that, following the incident involving car No. 86 on SS4, red flags were sent electronically to four cars, amongst them car No. 96. A physical red flag was also displayed at radio posts preceding the incident but car No. 96 had already passed these points. The crew of car No. 96 acknowledged having received the electronic flags as required pursuant to Article 40.5.1 of the 2017 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations but according to the tracking data, they did not slow down for the remainder of the stage.

Upon being summoned, the above Driver and Co-driver of car No. 96 met the Stewards at 19:04 hrs on Friday, 10.02.2017 by the means of a videoconference.

They stated that they had confirmed the red flag but it was only received after the second press (after the SS) and after having passed the accident they thought that it was ok to drive competitively until the end of the stage.

The Stewards then, after due deliberation

DECIDE

To impose a fine of € 250 on Competitor No. 96 for not having complied with Articles 40.5.1 and 40.5.3 of the 2017 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations.

The Competitor is reminded of the right to appeal as stipulated in the FIA International Sporting Code.
