The Stewards received a report from the Clerk of the Course stating that, following the incident involving car No. 86 on SS4, red flags were sent electronically to four cars, amongst them car No. 61. A physical red flag was also displayed at radio posts preceding the incident but car No. 61 had already passed these points. The crew of car No. 61 did not acknowledge having received the electronic flags as required pursuant to Article 40.5.1 of the 2017 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations but according to the tracking data, they slowed down for the remainder of the stage.

Upon being summoned, the above Driver and Co-driver of car No. 61 met the Stewards at 19:08 hrs on Friday, 10.02.2017 by the means of a videoconference.

They stated that they had noticed the red flag, slowed immediately down to a safe speed until the end of the stage but they did not know that a confirmation is needed.

The Stewards then, after due deliberation

DECIDE

To impose a reprimand on Competitor No. 61 for not having complied completely with Article 40.5.1 of the 2017 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations.

The Competitor is reminded of the right to appeal as stipulated in the FIA International Sporting Code.
