The Stewards received a report from the Clerk of the Course, with documentary evidence attached, stating that the crew of car No. 61 stopped on special stage SS14 on Saturday 11.2.2017 at 16:18 hrs and failed to activate the OK switch on the emergency console within one minute as stipulated in Art. 40.3.3 of the 2017 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations.

The crew was then informed accordingly by the Stewards and was given the possibility, if they wished, to bring forward any representations other than having forgotten to push the button within one minute in the heat of the moment.

The competitor declared that they wanted to make representations. The driver and the co-driver were then heard by the Stewards via video conference on Saturday evening at 18.25 hrs.

They explained that when they were in the ditch and were trying to rejoin the road with spectators pushing the car, they thought they could move again within one minute. They apologized for their lapse.

The Stewards consider that a breach of Article 40.3.3 of the 2017 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations has been committed and having further considered that Ms LOUISE COOK is a P3 driver, after due deliberation

DECIDE

That Driver LOUISE COOK and the Co-driver STEFAN DAVIS shall be jointly and severally liable to pay a **fine of € 1,000.**

The Competitor is reminded of her right to appeal.
