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FIA Environment accreditation

Rally Sweden was the one of the first motor sport event in the world to achieve the accreditation "Achievement of Excellence" from the FIA Institute's environment programme. During 2022 Rally Sweden achieved Three stars, the highest level, in the FIA's environmental accreditation framework. Rally Sweden has thus received an important quality receipt for its environmental and climate work.

The move to Umeå meant that Rally Sweden could take several important steps towards the vision of zero emissions, Rally Towards Zero. Extensive use of fixed electricity from renewable and locally produced sources improved opportunities for visitors to get to the arenas by public transport and cooperation with several environmentally certified key suppliers were some of the environmental advances.

One factor is the number of print-outs made from various documents. Rally Guide 1 og 2 as well as the Supplementary Regulations will only be published on the event website.

We would appreciate all competitors joining us for this management by informing us early the number of Road Books needed (should be less than the regulatory package), so we do not end up throwing a lot of unused documents to recycling.

As one of Sweden's largest spectator event Rally Sweden shall be a leader and good example in environmental work both nationally and internationally. We will profile Rally Sweden as an organizer that puts the environment in all areas all year round, even if the rally takes place in the winter. We want the entire organization to be engaged in environmental work and that each employee and marshal takes environmental considerations into the decisions taken.

Successively Rally Sweden through conscious choice will work for the environmental impact to be reduced and we will:

- o Commit to continuously improve our environmental work.
- o Define clear goals and frameworks for our environmental work.
- o Educate and inform as many people as possible both within the organisation and externally of our environmental policy.

1. WELCOME AND INTRODUCTION

It is our honour to welcome you to Sweden and the 70th edition of Rally Sweden! The rally will take place 9th - 12th of February in the region of Västerbotten in the north of Sweden. Our second time in Umeå and we are looking forward to some proper snow stages.

Locations

The HQ, Media Centre and Service Park will be located at the Nolia Exhibition and Sports arena, in central Umeå.

Umeå's distinctive strengths, in addition to a stable winter climate, are good hotel capacity in combination with Service Park and HQ at the Nolia exhibition and sports area, strongly growing business community and an attractive catchment area in terms of audience.

Route

The total length of the route is 1194,16 km and the special stage length is 301,18 km. The rally has 62,2% new stages in the itinerary.

After the shakedown stage on Thursday morning 9th February, the start of the rally will be in the evening at the Red Barn Arena podium in Umeå followed by the first stage, Umeå sprint.

4.5 DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR ADMINISTRATIVE CHECKS

When sending the online registration entry form to the FIA, the competitors are also required to send the following documents to <u>entry@rallysweden.com</u> by 30 January at the latest. The entry application will only be accepted if accompanied by:

- Proof of payment of the total amount of entry fees (incl. VAT)
- Copies of the Competitor and Driver and Co-driver competition licences
- Copies of the Driver and Co-driver passports or Identity cards
- Copies of the Driver and Co-driver driving licences
- One passport photo for driver and co-driver
- First page of the car homologation papers with the number, group and cylinder capacity
- Copies of the car's registration papers
- Copies of the insurance cover (third parties) for the rally car (Green Card)
- Copies of the insurance cover for repatriation (non-Swedish crews)
- ASN authorisation, where applicable
- Copy of the entry form duly signed

By sending the signed entry form, the competitor and the crew submit themselves to the sporting jurisdictions specified in the 2023 FIA International Sporting Code and its appendices, the 2023 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations and these Supplementary Regulations (WRC SR Art. 22.5).

According to Article 3.9.4 of the Code, foreign competitors (drivers and co-drivers) need to present their ASN (National Sporting Authority) authorisation giving permission to participate in the Rally Sweden 2023.



5. SERVICE PARK 5.1 LOCATION

GPS Coordinates: N63° 50.050 ´ E20° 14.525 ´ The service park will be established at <u>Nolia Exhibition area</u> in Umeå (see city map in Appendix 2).

Manufacturers and other championship entrants will be allocated a designated space in accordance with 2023 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations.

Legal entrants are allocated an area of 10 m x 10 m and private entrants are allocated an area of 12 m x 8 m. A provisional drawing of the service park is enclosed in Appendix 2 (Maps and drawings).

5.2 SERVICE AND AUXILIARY VEHICLES

Service Vehicles

Service vehicles only (identified with Service plates issued by the organizer) are allowed to enter and exit the Service Park. Service cars are only allowed to set-up at times according to Art. 5.4.

For Manufacturers to access the designated service space during the rally the vehicles must carry a Service plate and use the auxiliary entrance. The Vehicle must be parked inside the designated area. For WRC2, WRC3 and Non-priority to access the designated service space during the rally the vehicles must carry a Service plate and use the auxiliary entrance. The vehicle must be parked inside the designated area. Roads and space are limited at the service park. Please respect service times to avoid congestion.

The number of service plates allowed is included in the entry fee (see Appendix VI in the 2023 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations and Art 4.5 in the Supplementary Regulations).

Auxiliary Vehicles

For access to the Auxiliary parking area the vehicles must carry an Auxiliary plate or Service plate. Auxiliary plates are in some cases included in the entry fee (see Appendix VI in the 2023 FIA WRC Regulations and Art 4.5. in the Supplementary Regulations). Additional Auxiliary plates may be ordered by using the order form included in Appendix 5.

Trailer Parking

There is a trailer parking 5 minutes from service park (see map in Appendix 2). Trailer parking is open every day from 07:00am to 07:00pm

5.3 RESTRICTIONS ON THE SERVICE PARK

It is forbidden under any circumstances to drill holes in the tarmac or the ground at the Service Park. Teams and competitors are asked to bring weights for tents and others that need to be fastened.

Teams and competitors are responsible for the occurrence of no leakage of fuel or other liquids on the ground. All fuel connection to heaters and power generators must be visible. Any detected fuel leakage may force the teams to dismantle their units and tents during the rally.

Inspection will be performed during the weekend.

Smoking is forbidden in the refuelling-zones and at the overnight parc ferme.

As soon as possible after retirement, contact Secretary of the Rally, Vera Bakke Andresen, tel: +47 419 054 54 for information concerning recovery of the car and other procedures. A competitor who is retiring and do not wish to re-start must complete the retirement form in the Road Book and lodging it with the organiser as soon as possible before the publication of the re-start list.

If the rallycar is transported by van/trailer, the Media Zone / Tech.zone gate is to be used for entering the Service Park. For priority drivers: the time card for the limited service will be given at the service park.

The Swedish Transport Agency, Civil Aviation Department, has declared the airspace above the rally area as "Restricted Area". Only helicopters registered with the organiser and following the instructions of the Swedish Transport Agency and the organiser, are allowed to operate in this area.

Note! All foreign Aerial Work operators must obtain permission for flying in Sweden from the Swedish Transport Agency. For further information please contact:

Medical information for Sweden

Citizens from the EU/EEA - countries will receive emergency medical care paying the same patient charge as Swedish citizens. Competitors from these countries must provide a European Health Insurance Card verifying that the person is covered by health insurance, when medical care is required, and should obtain this form before leaving their home country. Citizens from the Nordic countries are not required to provide the European Health Insurance Card.

Besides the EU/EEA-countries Sweden has an agreement with the following countries which guarantees the citizens emergency medical care at the same patient charge as Swedish citizens: Algeria and Australia. Competitors from these countries must also provide a European Health Insurance Card, EU card or corresponding document verifying that the person is covered by health insurance. Citizens in other countries than mentioned above must pay the total cost of treatment plus the patient charge.

When competing outside their countries, crews must have taken out an international insurance policy covering their repatriation, if necessary, after an accident.
