FIA Environment accreditation

Rally Sweden has become the first motor sport event in the world to achieve accreditation from the FIA Institute's environment programme. The framework forms part of a broader initiative between the FIA and the FIA Institute aimed at evaluating and reducing the environmental impact of motor sport.

One important factor is the number of print-outs made from various documents. Rally Guide 1 and 2 as well as the Supplementary Regulations will only be published on the event website.

We would appreciate all competitors joining us for this management by informing us early the number of Road Books they need (should be less than the regulatory package), so we do not end up throwing a lot of unused materials to recycling.

The rally will take place 24th - 27th of February in the region of Västerbotten in the north of Sweden.

As you all know we were forced to cancel our event in 2021 because of the pandemic restrictions at the time. Even though these exceptional times continue, we trust that with the help of successful vaccination programmes worldwide we will be able to run the event as normal as possible.

Locations

The HQ, Media Centre and Service Park will be located at the Nolia Exhibition and Sports arena, in central Umeå.

Umeå's distinctive strengths, in addition to a stable winter climate, are good hotel capacity in combination with Service Park and HQ at the Nolia exhibition and sports area, strongly growing business community and an attractive catchment area in terms of audience.

The total length of the route is 1339,80 km and the special stage length is 305,79 km. The rally has 100% new stages in the itinerary.

- ASN authorisation, where applicable.

By sending an electronic form, the competitor and crew undertakes to abide by the rules and regulations of the competition, as well as the prescriptions of the FIA WRC, Art. 22.5

According to Article 3.9.4 of the Code, foreign competitors (drivers and co-drivers) need to present their ASN (National Sporting Authority) authorisation giving permission to participate in the Rally Sweden 2022.



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5. SERVICE PARK

5.1 LOCATION

GPS Coordinates: N63° 50.050´ E20° 14.525´

The service park will be established at [Nolia Exhibition area](#) in Umeå (see city map in Appendix 2).

Manufacturers and other championship entrants will be allocated a designated space in accordance with 2022 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations.

Legal and private entrants are allocated an area of 10 m x 8 m.

A provisional drawing of the service park is enclosed in Appendix 2 (Maps and drawings).

From this year we are proud to be able to replace the electricity that is produced by diesel generators at the service park, with 100% sustainable electricity from renewable energy sources. Distributed from the power grid with high availability.

5.2 SERVICE AND AUXILIARY VEHICLES

Service Vehicles

Service vehicles only (identified with Service plates issued by the organizer) are allowed to enter and exit the Service Park. Service cars are only allowed to set-up at times according to Art. 5.4.

For Manufacturers to access the designated service space during the rally the vehicles must carry a Service plate and use the auxiliary entrance. The Vehicle must be parked inside the designated area. For WRC2, WRC3 and Non-priority to access the designated service space during the rally the vehicles must carry a Service plate and use the auxiliary entrance. The vehicle must be parked inside the designated area. Roads and space are limited at the service park. Please respect service times to avoid congestion.

The number of service plates allowed is included in the entry fee (see Appendix VI in the 2022 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations and Art 4.5 in the Supplementary Regulations).

Auxiliary Vehicles

For access to the Auxiliary parking area the vehicles must carry an Auxiliary plate or Service plate.

Auxiliary plates are in some cases included in the entry fee (see Appendix VI in the 2022 FIA WRC Regulations and Art 4.5. in the Supplementary Regulations). Additional Auxiliary plates may be ordered by using the order form included in Appendix 5.

Trailer Parking

There is a trailer parking 5 minutes from service park (see map in Appendix 2). Trailer parking is open every day from 07:00am to 07:00pm

5.3 RESTRICTIONS ON THE SERVICE PARK

It is forbidden under any circumstances to drill holes in the tarmac or the ground at the Service Park. Teams and competitors are asked to bring weights for tents and others that need to be fastened.

Teams and competitors are responsible for the occurrence of no leakage of fuel or other liquids on the ground. All fuel connection to heaters and power generators must be visible. Any detected fuel leakage may force the teams to dismantle their units and tents during the rally.

Inspection will be performed during the weekend.

Smoking is forbidden in the refuelling-zones and at the overnight parc ferme.

5.6 RETIREMENTS AND RE-STARTS

Competitors retiring before the start of section 1, 3 and 7 will be assumed to restart the rally at the next section following an overnight regroup. As soon as possible after retirement, contact Secretary of the Rally, Vera Bakke Andresen, tel: +47 419 054 54 for information concerning recovery of the car and other procedures. A competitor who is retiring and do not wish to re-start must complete the retirement form in the Road Book and submit the form to the organiser at the earliest convenience.

If the rallycar is transported by van/trailer, the Media Zone / Tech.zone gate is to be used for entering the Service Park . For priority drivers: the time card for the limited service will be given at the service park.

8. IMPORT OF VEHICLES AND SPARE PARTS

From the European Union.

Competitors from the European Union do not need to make any special custom clearance for temporary import of cars and equipment on arrival in Sweden.

From outside the European Union

The Swedish Transport Agency, Civil Aviation Department, has declared the airspace above the rally area as "Restricted Area". Only helicopters registered with the organiser and following the instructions of the Swedish Transport Agency and the organiser, are allowed to operate in this area.

15.1 CEREMONIAL START PROCEDURE

Ceremonial Start attendance is compulsory for all competing crews and their cars. The Ceremonial Start takes place in Umeå city centre on Thursday 24th of February starting with first car on ramp at 20:00 hrs. The start interval will be 1 minute for all crews.

All P1 drivers must park their cars in the Ceremonial Start Parking Area immediately after completion of the preceding PR event.

All other drivers must have parked their cars 30 minutes prior to its individual starting time.

All competitors must wear their approved overalls.

The cars may be brought by a competitors' representative. The Parking Area will be closed and guarded.

Late arrival at the start ramp up to 15 minutes after a competitor's due time will be penalised with €120. Arrival after 15 minutes will be reported to the Stewards.

No Time Cards will be issued. After the Ceremonial Start, rally cars are free until presented at TC O."

15.2 WAITING ROOM / LOUNGE

At the place for the autograph signing, there will be a waiting room available in the building, Väven.

16. FINISH CEREMONY AND PRIZE-GIVING PROCEDURE

The finish of the rally is TC 19A. All cars subject to SS19 Powerstage during live TV must give interviews at the STOP control. After finishing SS19, the current top three drivers must stay in the Powerstage Podium Waiting Area adjacent to the Powerstage finish, and attend the Powerstage Podium Ceremony. All cars must, after completing their obligations at the Powerstage, immediately drive to TC 19A and the Finish Ceremony Holding Area. Drivers and Co-Drivers should then without delay proceed to 'Väven' for interviews with media."

All drivers are obliged to drive their cars over the ramp in the order instructed by the marshals. The Prize Giving procedure at the podium will be as follows:

- WRC2 top three
- JWRC top three
- WRC3 top three
- All other competitors

Team Principal and/or Representative(s) of the winning manufacturer are requested for the Prize Giving Ceremony, and are directed to the Holding Area prior the Ceremony, located in the same place as the Autograph Signing session. Team members of the winning team are welcome to join the celebration and group photo on stage. There's a reserved team waiting area in front of the podium for this purpose.

Drivers and Co-Drivers will drive their respective cars to the Tech Zone IN after they've completed their obligations at the Finish Ceremony.

Medical information for Sweden

Citizens from the EU/EEA - countries will receive emergency medical care paying the same patient charge as Swedish citizens. Competitors from these countries must provide a European Health Insurance Card verifying that the person is covered by health insurance, when medical care is required, and should obtain this form before leaving their home country. Citizens from the Nordic countries are not required to provide the European Health Insurance Card.

Besides the EU/EEA-countries Sweden has an agreement with the following countries which guarantees the citizens emergency medical care at the same patient charge as Swedish citizens: Algeria and Australia. Competitors from these countries must also provide a European Health Insurance Card, EU card or corresponding document verifying that the person is covered by health insurance. Citizens in other countries than mentioned above must pay the total cost of treatment plus the patient charge.

When competing outside their countries, crews must have taken out an international insurance policy covering their repatriation, if necessary, after an accident.
