The rally will take place 24th - 27th of February in the region of Västerbotten in the north of Sweden.

As you all know we were forced to cancel our event in 2021 because of the pandemic restrictions at the time. Even though these exceptional times continue, we trust that with the help of successful vaccination programmes worldwide we will be able to run the event as normal as possible.

Locations

The HQ, Media Centre and Service Park will be located at the Nolia Exhibition and Sports arena, in central Umeå.

Umeå's distinctive strengths, in addition to a stable winter climate, are good hotel capacity in combination with Service Park and HQ at the Nolia exhibition and sports area, strongly growing business community and an attractive catchment area in terms of audience.

We have high hopes for both the commercial and sporting development at Rally Sweden in this new chapter with Umeå as host city.

Route

The total length of the route is 1329,04 km and the special stage length is 303,74 km. The rally has 100% new stages in the itinerary.

After the shakedown stage on Thursday morning 24th February, there will be a ceremonial start in Umeå city in the evening. The first stage will be on Friday morning the 25th of February.

FIA Environment accreditation

Rally Sweden has become the one of the first motor sport event in the world to achieve the accreditation "Achievement of Excellence" from the FIA Institute's environment programme. The framework forms part of a broader initiative between the FIA and the FIA Institute aimed at evaluating and reducing the environmental impact of motor sport.

One important factor is the number of print-outs made from various documents. Rally Guide 1 og 2 as well as the Supplementary Regulations will only be published on the event website.

We would appreciate all competitors joining us for this management by informing us early the number of Road Books needed (should be less than the regulatory package), so we do not end up throwing a lot of unused documents to recycling.

From this year we are proud to be able to replace the electricity that is produced by diesel generators at the service park, with 100% sustainable electricity from renewable energy sources. Distributed from the power grid with high availability.

4.2 ENTRY PROCEDURE

Closing date and time for entries: 24 January at 15:00hrs (CET)

Those wishing to take part in Rally Sweden 2022 must register and fill in the electronic entry form published at <https://registrations.fia.com/wrcswe> (available from 22 December 2021) duly completed before the closing date for entries. The entry will only be accepted if accompanied by the total amount of the Entry fee. To be accepted, competitors must send a proof of payment of the entry fee by e-mail to the assistant secretary of the rally (vera@rallysweden.com) by the closing date of entries. Foreign drivers must submit an approval from their ASN.

Entrants who wish to score points in FIA Championships, must make their entries by using the electronic standard rally entry form for their championship, available in the FIA application at <https://registrations.fia.com>.

4.3 ENTRY FEES

4.3.1 Manufacturer and other Championship entrants

Entry fees for Manufacturers, WRC, WRC2 and WRC3 Teams registered in the World Rally Championship as stipulated by the FIA, with local VAT added (6%).

4.3.2 Other Legal Entrants

Legal Entrant = The competing car entered by a team (not a Championship entrant) a company or other legal entity (with legal entrants licence).

Entry fee: 59 000 SEK + 6 % VAT

4.3.3 Private Entrant

Private Entrant = The competing car is entered by the driver or the co-driver.

Entry fee: 39 000 SEK + 6 % VAT

4.3.4 Private Entrant from Sweden

Non-priority drivers from one of mentioned countries, with the car entered by the driver or the co-driver

Entry fee: 25 000 SEK + 6 % VAT

4.3.5 Reconnaissance Only

Fee for reconnaissance only : 12 500 SEK + 6 % VAT

9.1 HELICOPTERS

The Swedish Transport Agency, Civil Aviation Department, has declared the airspace above the rally area as "Restricted Area". Only helicopters registered with the organiser and following the instructions of the Swedish Transport Agency and the organiser, are allowed to operate in this area.

For safety reasons, the number of helicopters operating in the area will be limited to 30. In addition, briefing for all pilots is mandatory and at the briefing you will receive an information manual containing timetables, maps and information about the Service Park, the special stages, GPS coordinates, refuel information, radio frequencies to be used etc. An administrative fee of 10 000 SEK (excl. VAT) will be charged for this service.

Operators must send the registration form in Rally Guide 2, Appendix 5 Forms together with necessary permissions no later than 8th of February. The form will also be published on Rally Sweden website.

18.2 MEDIA ACCREDITATION PROCEDURES

The Media Pass is considered as a working tool for journalists, and it cannot be used for public relations, promotions or entertainment purposes. No advertising, public relation agency or similar company or organisation will be accredited as media. Nor will the rally issue any media accreditation to representatives (press officers or otherwise) of sponsors, suppliers, teams, drivers etc. Exemptions will be made solely by the FIA WRC Media Delegate.

The Accreditation Guidelines and criteria for 2022 FIA WRC Events are published on the FIA website. Please carefully read the Accreditation Guidelines and watch the Media Safety Video to ensure all the requested information is included and that the application is forwarded to the correct organisation before submitting the application.

18.2.1 National media

Applications from Swedish and Norwegian print and website media, television and radio broadcasters, will be made through a form which can be found at rallysweden.com/media between the opening and closing time. All television and radio broadcasters' applications will be relayed and liaised with WRC Promoter by the Accreditation Officer. For more information about the content of the application and accreditation guidelines in Swedish, please refer to the instructions on the website. Our accreditation office can assist you with questions regarding your application, please e-mail accreditation@rallysweden.se for assistance.

Once received, the press office will confirm the receipt of the application by email. After the deadline the list of proposed national media accreditations will be sent to FIA for final approval. Confirmation of the accreditation together with further instructions will be sent via email once the accreditation is confirmed by the FIA.

If the application is successful, an Individual Acknowledgement will be included in the confirmation email. This document is to be signed both, by the editor of the publication, and the accredited party. The document must be presented, when arriving to the event to collect credentials. **NO ACCREDITATION CAN BE COLLECTED WITHOUT THIS DOCUMENT.**

NB! The central and local offices of the major international press agencies will always be accredited solely by the FIA.

19. MEDICAL AND SAFETY SERVICE

Medical information for Sweden

Citizens from the EU/EEA - countries will receive emergency medical care paying the same patient charge as Swedish citizens. Competitors from these countries must provide a European Health Insurance Card verifying that the person is covered by health insurance, when medical care is required, and should obtain this form before leaving their home country. Citizens from the Nordic countries are not required to provide the European Health Insurance Card.

Besides the EU/EEA-countries Sweden has an agreement with the following countries which guarantees the citizens emergency medical care at the same patient charge as Swedish citizens: Algeria and Australia. Competitors from these countries must also provide a European Health Insurance Card, EU card or corresponding document verifying that the person is covered by health insurance. Citizens in other countries than mentioned above must pay the total cost of treatment plus the patient charge.
