## **1. WELCOME AND INTRODUCTION**

**It is our honour to welcome you to Sweden and the 71st edition of Rally Sweden!**

**The rally will take place 15th - 18th of February in the region of Västerbotten in the north of Sweden. Our third time in Umeå and we are looking forward to some proper snow stages.**

### **Locations**

**The HQ, Media Centre and Service Park will be located at the Nolia Exhibition and Sports arena, in central Umeå.**

**Umeå's distinctive strengths, in addition to a stable winter climate, are good hotel capacity in combination with Service Park and HQ at the Nolia exhibition and sports area, strongly growing business community and an attractive catchment area in terms of audience.**

### **Route**

**The total length of the route is 1104,30 km and the special stage length is 301,76 km. The rally has 35,7% new stages in the itinerary.**

**After the shakedown stage on Thursday morning 15th February, the start of the rally will be in the evening at the Red Barn Arena podium in Umeå followed by the first stage, Umeå sprint.**

### **4.2 ENTRY PROCEDURE**

Closing date and time for entries: 16 January 2024

Those wishing to take part in Rally Sweden 2024 must register and fill in the electronic entry form published at <https://registrations.fia.com/wrcswe> (available from 15 December 2023) duly completed before the closing date for entries. The entry will only be accepted if accompanied by the total amount of the Entry fee. To be accepted, competitors must send a proof of payment of the entry fee by e-mail to the assistant secretary of the rally ([anna.obrand@rallysweden.com](mailto:anna.obrand@rallysweden.com)) by the closing date of entries. Foreign drivers must submit an approval from their ASN.

Entrants who wish to score points in FIA Championships, must make their entries by using the electronic standard rally entry form for their championship, available in the FIA application at <https://registrations.fia.com>.

### **4.3 ENTRY FEES**

#### **4.3.1 Manufacturer and other Championship entrants**

Entry fees for Manufacturers, WRC, WRC2 and WRC3 Teams registered in the World Rally Championship as stipulated by FIA World Rally Championship Sporting Regulations, Appendix VI, with local VAT added (6%).

#### **4.3.2 Other Legal Entrants**

Legal Entrant = The competing car entered by a team (not a Championship entrant) a company or other legal entity (with legal entrants licence).

Entry fee: 65 000 SEK + 6 % VAT

#### **4.3.3 Private Entrant**

Private Entrant = The competing car is entered by the driver or the co-driver.

Entry fee: 43 000 SEK + 6 % VAT

#### **4.3.4 Private Entrant from Sweden**

Non-priority drivers from one of mentioned countries, with the car entered by the driver or the co-driver

Entry fee: 30 000 SEK + 6 % VAT

## 5. SERVICE PARK

### 5.1 LOCATION AND SERVICE SPACE

The service park will be established at [Nolia Exhibition area](#) in Umeå (see city map in Appendix 2).

Manufacturers and other championship entrants will be allocated a designated space in accordance with 2024 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations.

Legal and private entrants are allocated an area of 10 m x 10 m.

Cost for additional service space in Service Park area:

Up to 20 m<sup>2</sup> = 250 SEK + 25 % VAT / m<sup>2</sup>

Over 20 m<sup>2</sup> = 475 SEK + 25 % VAT / m<sup>2</sup>

All additional space requests are subject to availability and organiser agreement. The organiser cannot



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guarantee any service space exceeding those given above and in the FIA WRC Sporting Regulations, Appendix VI. Requests received after 31 January will only be considered for a **doubled price, if at all.**

If a competitor has multiple competition cars to be located together in Service Park, the application for consecutive Service Areas must reach the Organiser by Tuesday, 31 January. **Applications after 31 January cannot be guaranteed.**

A provisional drawing of the service park is enclosed in Appendix 2 (Maps and drawings).

The electricity at the service park will be 100% sustainable electricity from renewable energy sources. Distributed from the power grid with high availability.

### 9.1 HELICOPTERS

The Swedish Transport Agency, Civil Aviation Department, has declared the airspace above the rally area as "Restricted Area". Only helicopters registered with the organiser and following the instructions of the Swedish Transport Agency and the organiser, are allowed to operate in this area.

For safety reasons, the number of helicopters operating in the area will be limited to 30. In addition, briefing for all pilots is mandatory and at the briefing you will receive an information manual containing time-tables, maps and information about the Service Park, the special stages, GPS coordinates, refuel information, radio frequencies to be used etc. An administrative fee of 10 000 SEK (excl. VAT) will be charged for this service.

Operators must send the registration form in Rally Guide 2, Appendix 5 Forms together with necessary permissions no later than 6th of February. The form will also be published on Rally Sweden website.

Citizens from the EU/EEA - countries will receive emergency medical care paying the same patient charge as Swedish citizens. Competitors from these countries must provide a European Health Insurance Card verifying that the person is covered by health insurance, when medical care is required, and should obtain this form before leaving their home country. Citizens from the Nordic countries are not required to provide the European Health Insurance Card.

Besides the EU/EEA-countries Sweden has an agreement with the following countries which guarantees the citizens emergency medical care at the same patient charge as Swedish citizens: Algeria and Australia. Competitors from these countries must also provide a European Health Insurance Card, EU card or corresponding document verifying that the person is covered by health insurance. Citizens in other countries than mentioned above must pay the total cost of treatment plus the patient charge.
