SAFETY

Motorsports can be dangerous and that's why we need your help. A driver can get a technical malfunction or for some other reason be unable to keep the car on the road. Because of this it is important where you as a spectator stand. The symbols seen below show where it is dangerous, and therefore forbidden, to stand. And please be aware that it is forbidden to walk on the stage within 30 minutes of the stage start. Keep this in mind and your rally experience will be exciting but safe.

SAFETY 3 3 hours before first WRC car. Route control.

SAFETY 2 1.45 hours before first WRC car. Time control function.

SAFETY1 1 hour before first WRC car. Stage and spectator safety.

FIA SAFETY 25 minutes before first WRC car. Stage and spectator safety.

00 WRC 20 minutes before first WRC car. Spectator safety.

OWRC 15 minutes before first WRC car. Spectator safety.

SWEEPER Closing the stage for competitors.

STAGE COMMANDER Opening the road for the spectators.

SAFETY CARS RALLY SWEDEN HISTORIC

Jump, Crest

On stages that include **Rally Sweden Historic.** these cars run before the first Historic car:

HOO HISTORIC 10 minutes before first Historic car. Spectator safety.

HOHISTORIC 5 minutes before first Historic car. Spectator safety.



NO DRONE ZONE!

Drones are prohibited during Rally Sweden for security reasons.



DON'T WALK! It is forbidden to walk

Respect the safety instructions as well as the environment. The rule is simple: Leave no one and nothing behind!



SNOWMOBILE PLEASE, STAY ON THE TRAILS!

During Rally Sweden there will be a lot of people and activity in the woods. Rally Sweden therefore strongly recommends that all snowmobile traffic stays on the trails within the competition area, and all "free riding" should be avoided. The impact on nature and the risk of frightening wild animals is thereby minimized. Keep in mind that reindeers can be located in the area and if they are frightened by the snowmobiles, they might accidently run towards the rally stages. This would cause a safety risk and in worst case the stage must be cancelled.

SHORT TIPS FOR THE BEST EXPERIENCE

- Empty your car of valuable belongings. Otherwise someone else might.
- Be on time at the stage! Remember that it is forbidden to walk on the stage. If you're running late walk beside the road.
- Follow the safety marshals instructions.
- Don't stand in forbidden areas. Standing in the wrong place may cause the stage to be delayed or even cancelled.
- Warm clothes are a must. Especially warm footwear.

#BeSafeTakeCare

We're all here to experience the rally, the action and the party up close. But rally is a sport with small margins, and there's no room for mistakes. Read the safety information. Follow the safety marshals' instructions. Take care of each other, and keep the party going. And equally important; don't forget to respect the environment as well as the safety instructions.

/ 📕 Minimum Waste

We want to create as little waste as possible. That's why we use real cutlery and crockery in our VIP tents, and the food sold out in the forest is mainly eaten without cutlery. We are phasing out all disposable plastic items and are working hard to prevent food waste. This is also about leaving the forest in the same condition as when we arrived – without leaving any rubbish behind.

You can do your part by:

- Not discarding any food.
- Throwing all your litter in the designated sacks and bins. This also applies to disposable barbecues, cans and bottles.
- Please take one of the bio-based bags, which are available close to all our entrances, to use for your rubbish, and discard them in our waste containers. You can also leave your bag clearly visible by the safety tape along the side of the track.
- If you go into the forest always bring all your waste back with you.

Smile, you're on camera!

Now, the FIA security officers will have full control of where you stand along the track - through the whole competition. By using the cars' onboard cameras directly in real time, the safety officers can immediately see what it looks like along the entire course.

If you come too close to the road or stand in dangerous places, the stage can be cancelled immediately. And there will be pictures of those causing the interruption.

Stages can be cancelled immediately if you don't respect the safety areas!

Right of Public Access

In Sweden we're quite unique in having something called 'Allemansrätten' (Right of Public Access). This means that everyone, by law, has free access to the great outdoors – so you can enjoy Rally Sweden from virtually anywhere along the various stage routes. But this right comes with responsibilities, the main one being that you should always leave the forest exactly as it was when you arrived.

Campfires

It is permitted to make fires in the forest – but you must NOT cut down trees or bushes, for firewood or any other purpose. This is a crime under Swedish law. You are also responsible for ensuring that no fire or glowing embers remain when you leave the site.

Reduce Emissions

We'll do our best to limit the environmental impact of our transports by streamlining transportation and using vehicles with the best environmental performance possible. We'll also use renewable energy sources wherever we can, and minimise our consumption of other fuels.

Here's how you can help us to make Rally Sweden the world's most eco-friendly rally:

- If possible, take the train to Umeå and the Rally bus out to the races. These are comfortable, convenient ways to travel and you avoid problems with parking.
- Use an electric or hybrid vehicle. Charging points are shown on the rally map. Or drive safe and eco-friendly with your fossil fueled vehicle.
- Car pool! Ideally several people can share a minibus.
- Flying to the event? Pay money into the Fly Green Fund and make a contribution to aviation biofuel.

LOOK FOR THE GREEN LIGHT

HY WRC

From 2022 onwards, all cars at the top level of the FIA World Rally Championship feature hybrid **electric** powertrains.

With this comes new precautions for spectators and safety crews in the event of a crash due to the **high-voltage** electrical current they can generate.

This is why you must always look for the **green** light whenever a car is stationary before touching it, as only this means the car is **safe**.

A flashing red light, along with an alarm sound, means the car is unsafe. No light means it is potentially unsafe. Only touch the car if there is a green light.

2 Safetylights are on the windscreen and both side pillars of the cars. Following an accident, a solid green light means it is safe to touch.

HY WRC

The HY symbol shows that this is a hybrid car. From 2022 onwards, all Rally1 cars have hybrid engines.
